Using the Bomag Roller

- Wear the protective equipment including safety boots and gloves
- Always keep hands, feet and clothing away from moving parts of the roller.
- The handles of the roller should be held firmly with two hands before pulling one of the control levers in - the steering arm may move unexpectedly as the drive is
- This roller can be turned and manoeuvred easily using the engine to drive it forwards and backwards. Do not try to move it with the drum or engine stopped.
- Check that there are no obstructions before driving the roller in reverse. Release the control lever straight away if it is necessary to stop the machine.
- Make sure that the support leg has been retracted before starting work.
- Do not use the roller on slopes that are too steep.
- The Bomag roller has a water sprinkler system, use it to help prevent the compacted surface sticking to the drum. The operating control is on the water tank on the opposite side to the filler cap.
- Watch out for signs that vibration may be affecting the hands. If fingers start to tingle or feel numb, take a short break from using the roller. Exercise the fingers to encourage blood circulation.
- 10. To help prevent vibration affecting the hands, operate the roller for shorter periods. Hands should be kept warm - wearing gloves may help to do this.
- 11. Do not operate the vibrating action on very hard surfaces such as concrete or
- 12. If an obstruction becomes jammed in the drum scraper, or something gets tangled in the drive mechanism, the engine must be stopped before clearing the
- 13. Stop the engine if leaving the machine unattended.
- 14. If the equipment does not work properly do not attempt to repair it. Contact the hire company.
